- The impact of violence or chronic conflict on children
- Behaviors to avoid
- · Helpful communication styles
- Effective co-parenting
- How to be a role model
- · Alternative dispute resolution
- The stages of grief and loss that children may experience
- How parents can respond to troubling behaviors and events in ways that are helpful
